- More help for working parents, breakfast club to start at 07:30am and after school club to 6pm?
- I would like more communication with how my child is getting on when he chats to the person that helps with his feelings.

- Happy for some additional homework.
- Notify me of events / days (non-uniform) sooner sometimes.
- Sometimes my child isn't happy about coming into school but collection she is happy.
- More info on what's going on in school like friends, playtime, lunch etc.
- Parents swearing in the school yard and smoking.
- Notice for events. Disagree comments relate to communication via reception, not tutor.
- Newsletter text is too small. Layout could be better with key dates highlighted.
- She seems worried about her reading and numbers, doesn't say she has much one to one.
- More home / school communication.
- Better communication with parents about daily activities.
- My child would like some work to do at home sometimes.
- Both parents at parents evening.
- Making it easier to raise our concerns and our concerns being dealt with and also I believe if my child fidgets constantly and bites her hair then there should be an acceptance on sensory things in school.
- I believe some teachers in the school need to understand kids with Autism better.
- More home / school communication.
- More choice for after school clubs.
- Contact me on my days!!
- Need an after club like breakfast club to help parents that work.
- Struggle getting her ready, she doesn't ever want to go to school.
- More teachers to have a better understanding of Autism.
