This Week

This week the children have been taking part in Presentation Week. On Monday I held an assembly focusing on this theme where the children learnt why it is so important to come into school. We spoke about the important things they learn and the benefits of presenting their work well. There will be Headteacher Awards given out during a special assembly in the coming weeks for the most improved and most outstanding work presented.

On Tuesday our Reception children were visited by the Coast Guard. They brought their truck and showed the children the equipment they use such as dry suits and ropes. They also showed the children the lights and the siren. Thank you to the Coast Guard for their time. The children had a wonderful time.

On Wednesday Year 2 children took part in a Space Experience Day which they thoroughly enjoyed. In the space dome the children learnt about planets, the solar system, stars and craters on the moon. They also had the opportunity to fly past the planets.



The children also learnt about the history of aircraft and looked at astronauts including Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins. They also learnt about a multicultural group of astronauts that will be going into space in the next few weeks. THIS WEEK'S ENERGY SAVING TIPS
