Hindu and Diwali Experience Day/Earthsong Hindu Music Experience

On Tuesday the children enjoyed a Hindu Diwali Experience Day with Alison and Yoga from Bhaktavidata Manor, the Hindu Temple in London, bought for the Hindu community by Beatle, George Harrison. They told the children the story of Diwali and showed them how they celebrate this festival, also known as the Festival of Lights. The children dressed up in the different costumes from the story and tried on sari's and masks. They were also given a bindi to put on their heads. All the children had a wonderful day.

On Wednesday/Thursday the children were visited by musicians Angela and Storme who showed the children lots of different Indian instruments including sitars, ghuttans, gopichans, tabla drums, tamporas, dhol drums and swarmandals which they saw and heard them play and were then able to learn to play themselves. They told

the "Ramayan" which is the ancient story of Rama and Sita, using puppets, and they listened to Storme sing the story to them in Hindi. The children also helped to act out the story. All the children thoroughly enjoyed the experience. It was lovely to see the children enjoying different instruments that they would not usually see. It was a very enjoyable couple of days and the children were able to have a deeper understanding of Diwali and the celebrations that go with this festival.
