### Covid 19

Please be assured we are regularly reviewing practice and doing everything we can possibly do to keep the children and our staff as safe as possible. School staff are wearing masks and each day the school undergoes a deep clean. There is also sanitiser and washing stations throughout the school which are being used regularly to keep everybody's hands clean.

### Social Distancing

I have met with a number of parents who have voiced concerns about the social distancing in the playground. Thank you to the parents who have been following the guidelines. Please ensure to socially distance when dropping your children to school and picking them up in the afternoon, as the risk of Covid is especially high at present. We do not have any confirmed cases in school.

### Covid Ventilated Classrooms

Ventilated classrooms will help to reduce the spread of Covid. Due to this additional ventilation please can the children come into school dressed in a vest, a white aertex top and a warm school jumper as the doors need to remain open, to circulate the air. Please can all the children also wear a coat to school, as the weather is becoming colder.

### Outdoor Play Equipment

We are seeing a number of children left unsupervised on the play equipment outside the classrooms. To reduce the spread of Covid and for the children's safety, please do not allow your child to go on the equipment before or after the school day.

Please make sure that your child completes their homework and brings it back for their teacher to mark. Please can you also read each evening with your child and comment in their reading log.

### **Labels**

Please make sure that all your child's clothing is labelled. Sometimes the children take off their cardigans and jumpers in the school hall if they are hot, and forget to pick them up. If your child's clothing is labelled, we can locate the piece of clothing much more easily.
